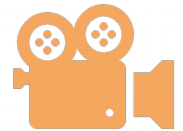

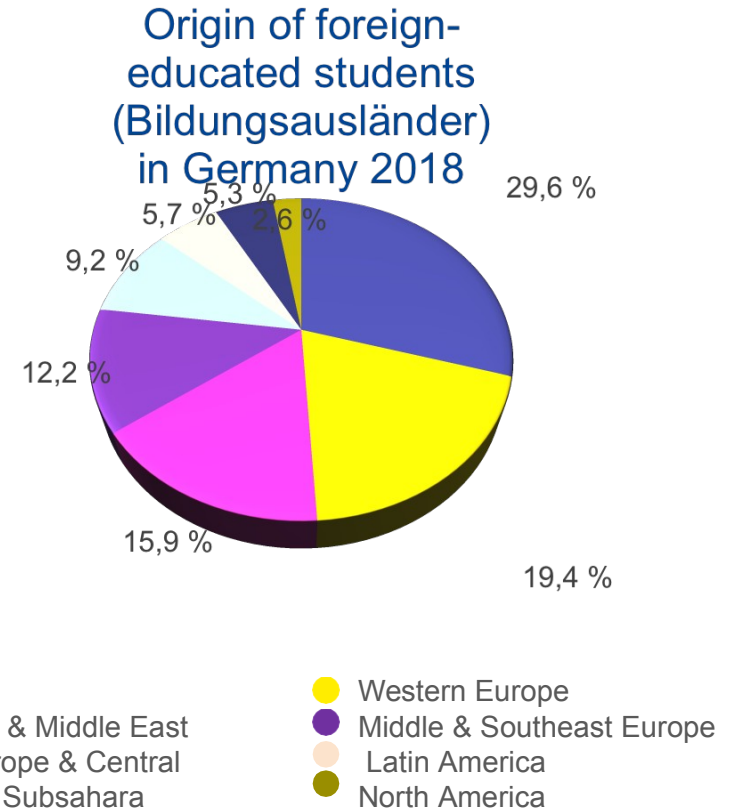

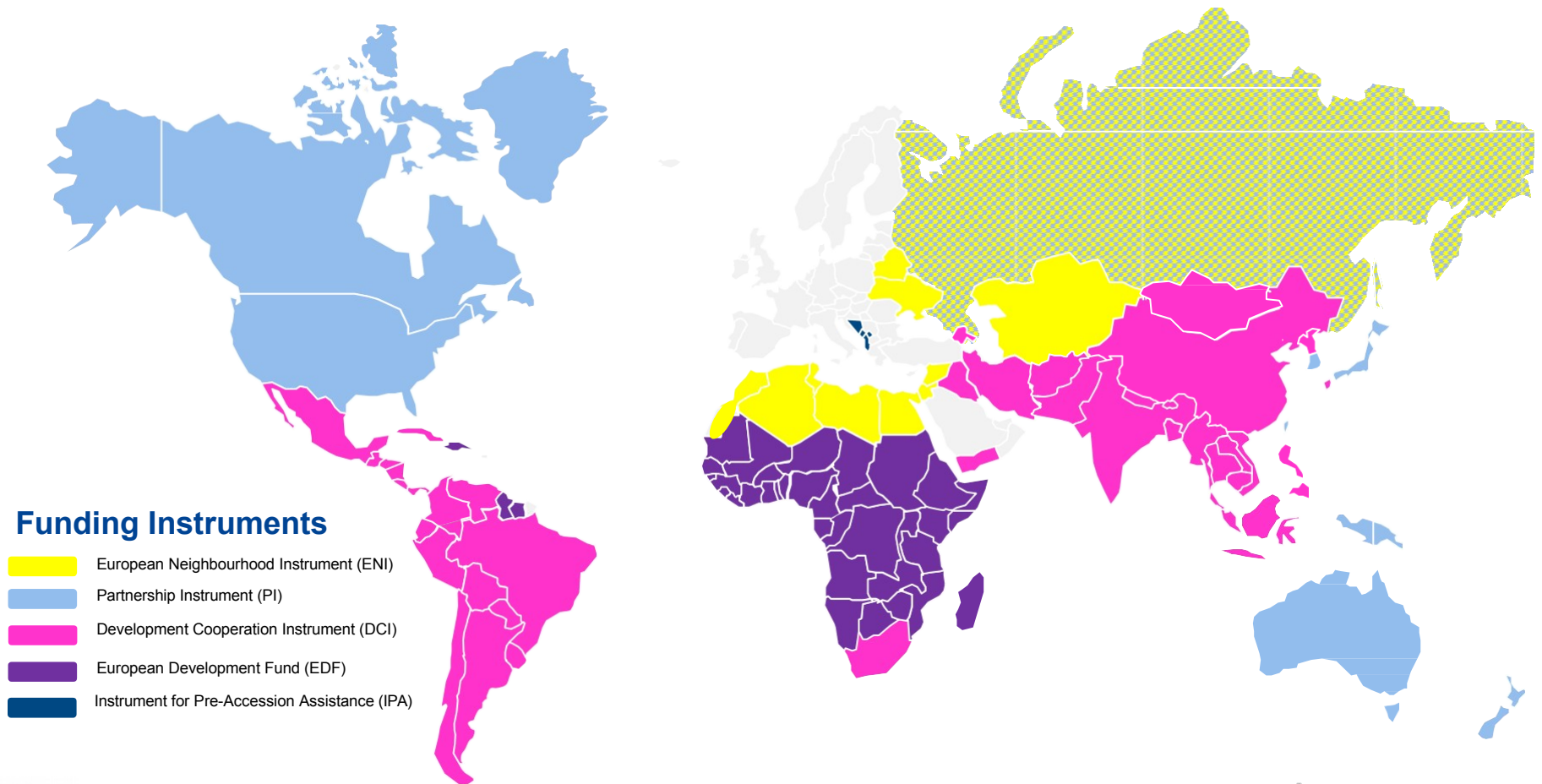
# HEI System Germany

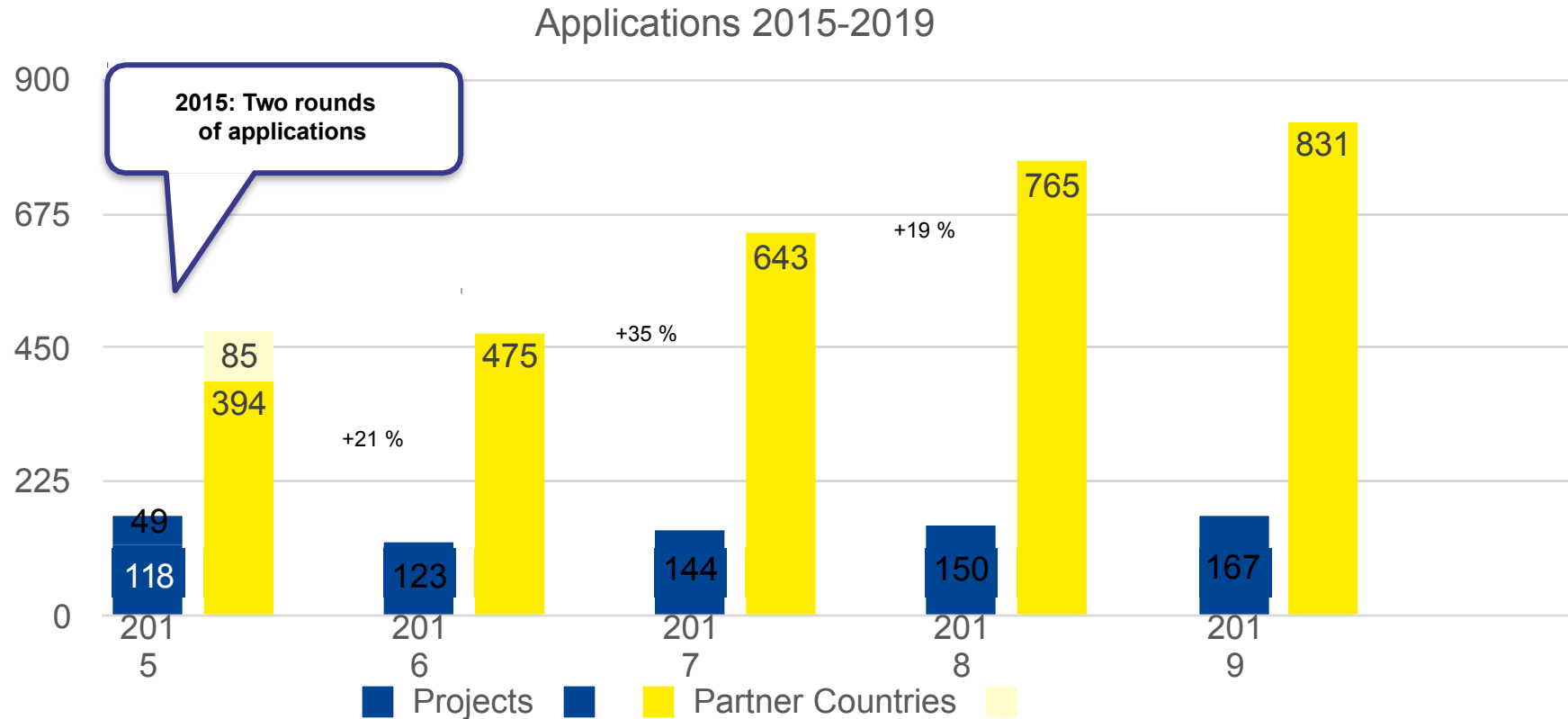

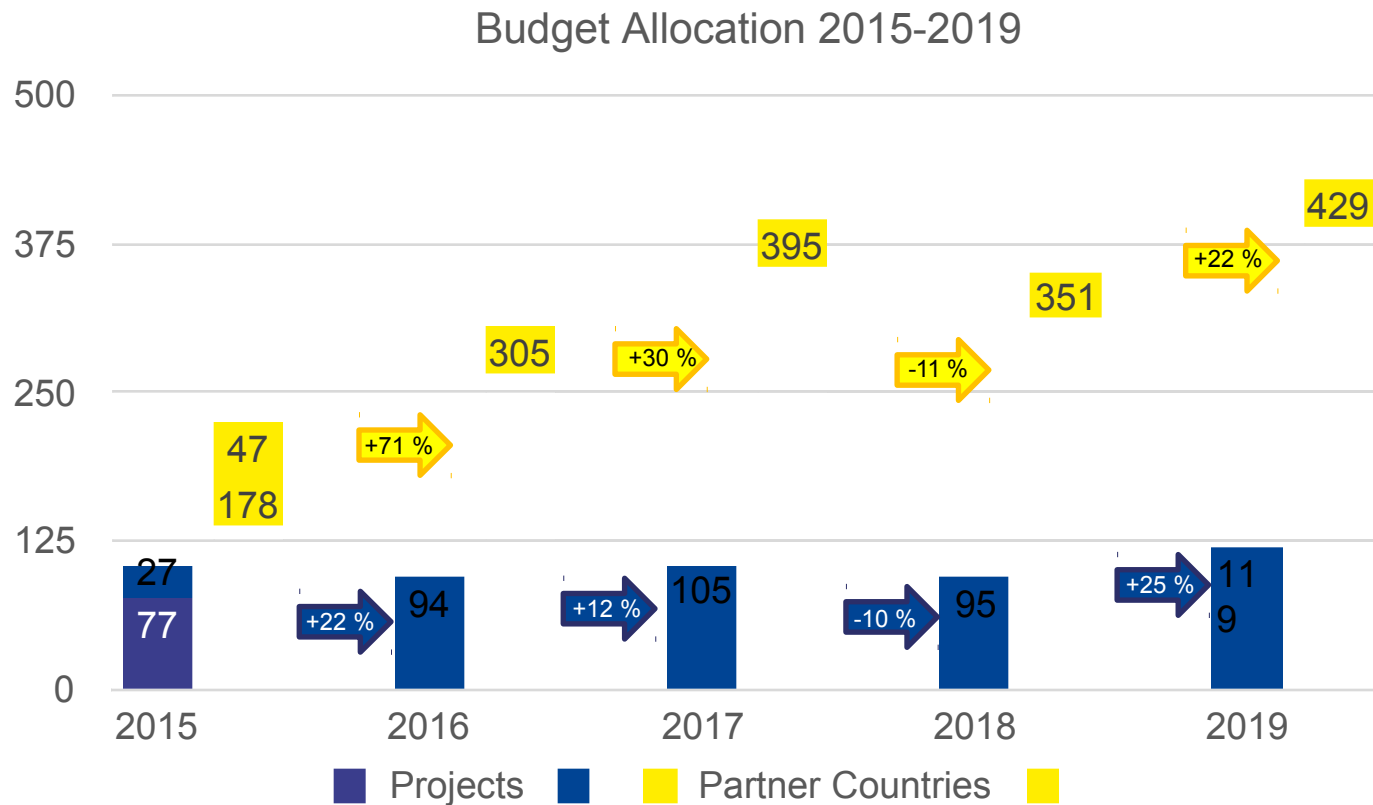

# Budget Allocation in KA107 2015-2018

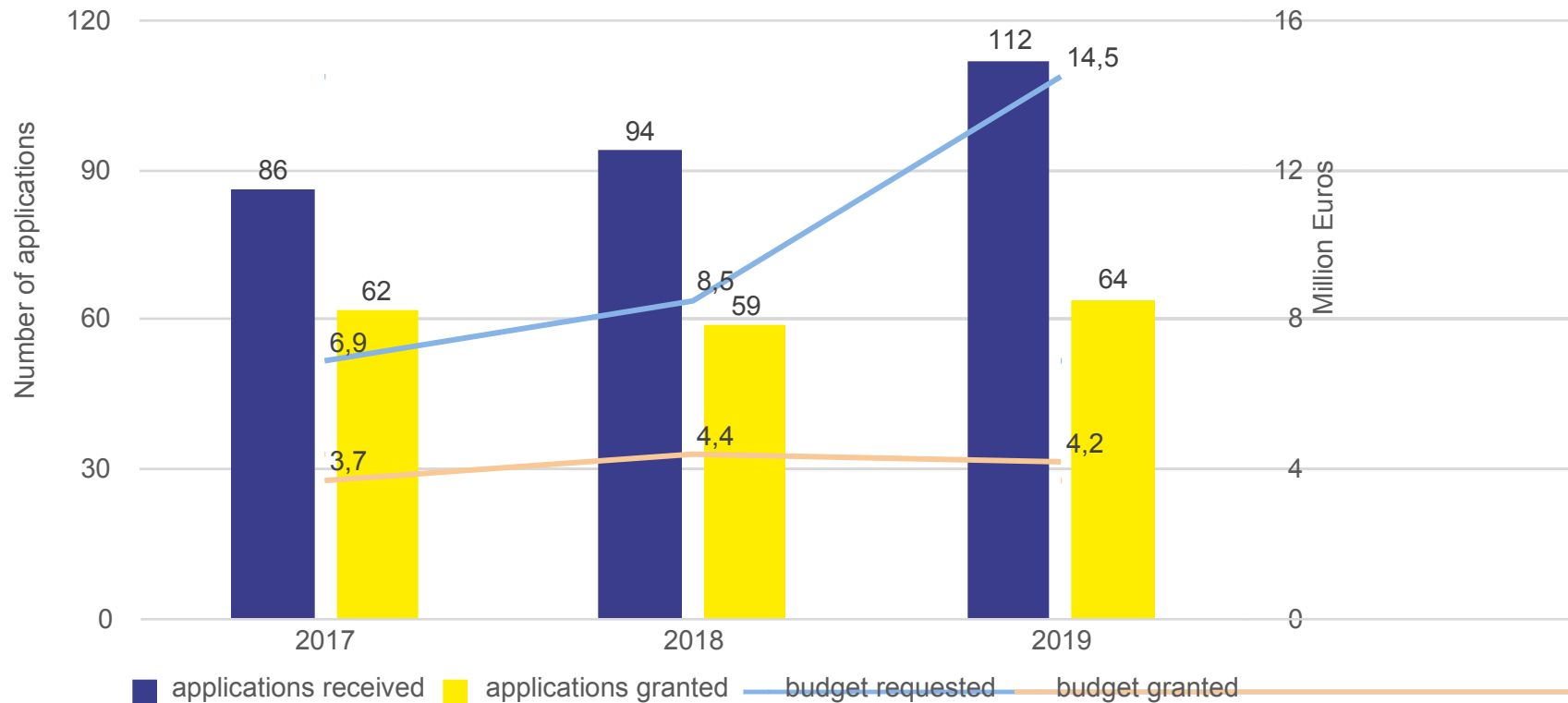

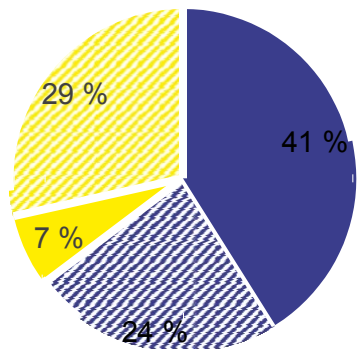

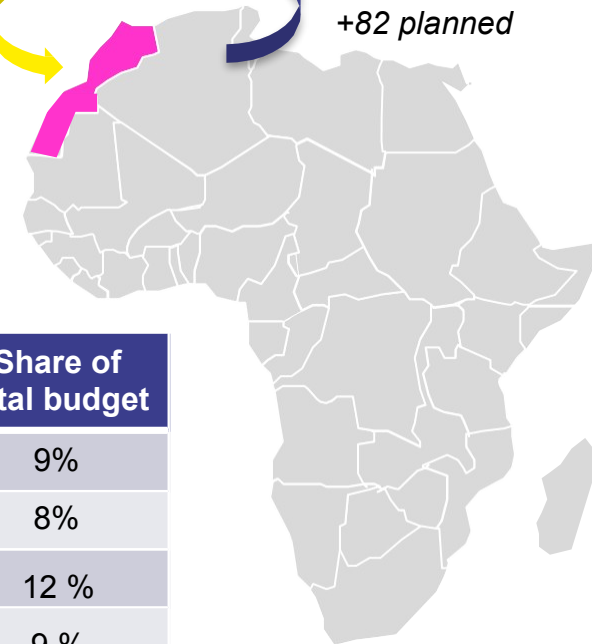

# Erasmus+ Programme Generation 2014-2020

## Higher Education – International Credit Mobility

2015

- International opening of Erasmus+
- Mobilities for students and staff from programme to partner countries and vice versa

2018

- Opening to non-academic organisations, funding traineeships (or work placements)

2015-2018

- 1,7 billion Euro for international credit mobility



# Erasmus+ Traineeships

By doing a traineeship abroad with Erasmus+, students can improve their communication, language and inter-cultural skills, their soft skills highly valued by future employers, as well as become more entrepreneurial

- Students enrolled in an higher education institution are eligible (all study cycles: BA, MA, PhD)
- Traineeship duration: 2-12 months
- Erasmus+ funding covers individual support and travel costs

# Erasmus+ Traineeships

## Which organisations are eligible?

- public or private, all sizes;
- public body at local, regional or national level;
- social partner or other representative of working life, including chambers of commerce, craft/professional associations and trade unions;
- research institute;
- foundation;
- school/institute/educational centre (at any level, from pre-school to upper secondary education, and including vocational education and adult education);
- non-profit organisation, association, NGO;
- body providing career guidance, professional counselling and information services.



# Erasmus+ Traineeships: Learning Agreement

## Responsibilities of receiving organisations:

### Before the mobility

- Confirm traineeship programm
- Commitment of the Learning Agreement of the three parties with original / scanned/ digital signatures.

### During the mobility

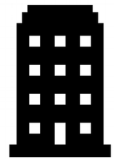
- If modifications are needed: An agreement by the three parties on the changes is possible via email/digital signatures.

### After the mobility

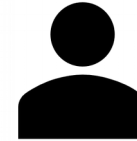
- Provide a Traineeship Certificate to the trainee and sending institution within 5 weeks.

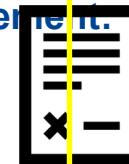
