








# **HEI System Germany**

- 5297 Moroccan degree seeking students (term 2017/2018)
















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# Applications in KA107 between 2015-2019










# **Budget Allocation in KA107 2015-2018**





# **Erasmus+ Traineeships**



By doing a traineeship abroad with Erasmus+, students can improve their communication, language and inter-cultural skills, their soft skills highly valued by future employers, as well as become more entrepreneurial

- Students enrolled in an higher education institution are eligible
  - (a|I study cycles: BA, MA, PhD)
- Traineeship duration: 2-12 months
- Erasmus+ funding covers individual support and travel costs







# **Erasmus+ Traineeships**

#### Which organisations are eligible?

- public or private, all sizes;
- public body at local, regional or national level;
- social partner or other representative of working life, including chambers of commerce, craft/professional associations and trade unions;
- research institute;
- foundation;
- school/institute/educational centre (at any level, from pre-school to upper secondary education, and including vocational education and adult education);
- non-profit organisation, association, NGO;

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body providing career guidance, professional counselling and information services.

## Responsibilities of receiving organisations:

#### Before the mobility


- Confirm traineeship programm
- Commitment of the Learning Agreement of the three parties with original / scanned/ digital signatures.

#### During the mobility

 If modifications are needed: An agreement by the three parties on the changes is possible via email/digital signatures.

#### After the mobility

 Provide a Traineeship Certificate to the trainee and sending institution within 5 weeks.
