“Cooperation and research for Higher Education and innovation”

Higher education faces challenges in adapting their teaching and governance model in order to respond to students demands, the labor market needs and the jobs of the future. In Particular, they must become flexible and dynamic to prepare for a future post-pandemic educational scenario. Among these challenges, the development of new learning and teaching practices including the use of technologies, the need to establish networks between higher education institutions to collaborate in an international scheme, the promotion of international mobility of students and staff, and the development of strategies and tools for the inclusion of people with few opportunities.

The action of the European Union in the field of higher education aims, among others, to promote cooperation between educational and scientific research institutions and to strengthen the capacity building of HEIs, students and staff through international mobility.

In this context, the Erasmus+ Morocco National Office organizes, in partnership with the Ministry of Higher Education, Scientific Research and Innovation, the EU Delegation to Morocco, the Conference of Universities Presidents (CPU), Cadi Ayyad University of Marrakech and the Islamic World Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (ICESCO), the first edition of the “Erasmus Scientific Days” on October 17th and 18th 2022 in Marrakech at Cadi Ayyad University convention center. These days are dedicated to high-level scientific exchange around the promotion of Higher Education and innovation through cooperation and research. The conference attempts to explore and foresight the **future** of higher education.

The “**Erasmus Scientific Days**” are an innovative and relevant action that targets to create synergies between Research and Education.

Erasmus Scientific Days gathers more than **150 participants** from **30 countries** from Europe, North and Latina America, South-Mediterranean region, Asia and Africa.

These days aim to :

► Bring together researchers and professors, PhD students, university officials, institutions and organizations working for and with higher education from **30 countries** in order to present **innovative initiatives** and **research** aimed at **building and strengthening the capacities** of institutions, staff, students and higher education graduates (completed or ongoing projects, studies, research work, etc.).

► Share knowledge around the areas of higher education and scientific research (including special sessions for PhD students).

► Promote and **valorize** the results of Erasmus+ projects, identify and **disseminate** good practices for the best **sustainability** through a **master class for project holders** and an **exhibition space**.

► Network and strengthen partnerships for innovative perspectives in higher education.

► Strengthen the potential of transforming international networking into quality scientific research and good practice in educational training and governance.

► Create **synergies** between Erasmus+ projects and other cooperation programs, in particular EU programs PRIMA and Horizon-Europe.

The selected papers will be published in an indexed book. The conference covers five main topics :

1. Learning and teaching practices
2. Digitalization and technology use in education
3. Inclusion, mobility and internationalization
4. Entrepreneurship and employability
5. Governance and Management

In an inclusive spirit, no registration fees are applied for the “Erasmus Scientific Days 2022”.

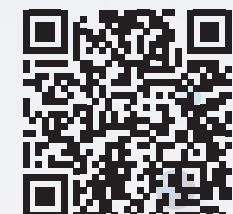

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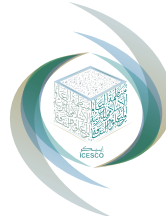


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
